Defendant Eugene Shields has filed a motion for reduction in his sentence under 18 U.S.C. § 3582(c)(2) and the recent amendment to the sentencing guidelines. Dkt. #88. Defendant's motion will be denied. On March 19, 2015, defendant filed a motion for appointment of counsel to assist him in filing such a motion. On December 7, 2015, I denied the motion because defendant did not qualify for a reduction. His sentence involved a variance and was not based on a sentencing range that was subsequently been lowered by the Sentencing Commission pursuant to 28 U.S.C. 994(*a*). Nothing has changed since the entry of the December 7, 2015 order and therefore defendant's motion for a reduction of sentence under 18 U.S.C. § 3582 is DENIED.
