On January 14, 2015, the court received defendant Scott Bodley's sworn affidavit of indigency (dkt. 111) which establishes that Bodley is financially unable to provide for transportation from his home in New Mexico to this court for the February 2, 2015, 9:00 a.m. jury selection and trial (preceded by the 8:00 a.m. final hearing). At the January 15, 2015 final pretrial conference, Bodley confirmed to the court that he has no funds to get here for trial. *See* Transcript, dkt. 123, at 6. Accordingly, pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 4285 and in the interests of justice,

It is ORDERED that:

(1) The United States Marshals Service shall arrange for defendant Scott Bodley's non-custodial transportation from Silver City, New Mexico, to Madison Wisconsin, scheduled so that Bodley arrives in Madison not later than the afternoon of Sunday, February 1, 2015; and,

(2) The United States Marshals Service shall furnish defendant Scott Bodley with an amount of money for his subsistence expenses to this courthouse, not to exceed the per diem amount authorized by 5 U.S.C. § 5702(a).
