Plaintiff Roderick D. Douglas filed a proposed civil action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983, concerning the conditions of his confinement in the Wisconsin Department of Corrections. On June 7, 2013, the court dismissed this action after Douglas failed to pay the filing fee as instructed or submit documentation in support of his motion for leave to proceed *in forma pauperis*. The dismissal was entered “without prejudice” to reopening if Douglas provided a certified trust account statement within ten days.

Douglas has now filed the requisite trust fund account statement in compliance with the federal *in forma pauperis* statute and this court’s order. (Dkt. #10). Accordingly, the court will vacate the dismissal order and direct the clerk’s office to reinstate this case for a determination whether Douglas is eligible for leave to proceed *in forma pauperis* for purposes of the Prison Litigation Reform Act, 28 U.S.C. §§ 1915(b), 1915A.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The order and judgment dismissing plaintiff Roderick D. Douglas's complaint on June 7, 2013 (Dkts. # 8, # 9) are VACATED.
2. The clerk's office shall REINSTATE this case to the court's active docket.
