On March 10, 2014, the defendant was sentenced to a one-year and one-day term of imprisonment. At the time of the sentencing hearing, restitution was unable to be determined. The defendant has subsequently waived his right to conduct a final restitution determination within 90 days of the date of his sentencing as granted under 18 U.S.C. § 3664(d)(5).

Additional information was gathered by both parties, making restitution determination possible. On July 2, 2014, the parties provided a stipulated agreement regarding restitution to the Court.

As to count one of the indictment, IT IS ORDERED that the defendant pay restitution in the amount of \$5,345,305.50 to the Clerk of Court for the Western District of Wisconsin to be disbursed as indicated in Appendix A. Before any payment to a restitution victim pursuant to this order, the victim shall certify in writing to the Clerk of Court that they have not sold any real property that was the subject of foreclosure from the defendant or obtained via agreement after the date of entry of this restitution order. In the event of such a sale, the restitution obligation shall be offset by that amount.

The defendant does not have the economic resources to allow him to make full payment of restitution in the foreseeable future under any reasonable schedule of payments. Pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3664(f)(3)(B), he is to begin making nominal payments of a minimum of \$50 each month, beginning within 60 days of the defendant's release from custody.

The defendant shall notify the Court and the Attorney General of any material change in the defendant's economic circumstances that might affect the defendant's ability to pay restitution.

No interest is to accrue on the unpaid portion of the restitution.

In all other respects, the judgment remains as entered on March 10, 2014.
