ORDER

The parties have filed a stipulation for attorney fees under the Equal Access to Justice Act, 28 U.S.C. § 2412. Dkt. #25. The stipulation is approved and IT IS ORDERED that plaintiff Mary Edwards is awarded attorney fees and costs in the amount of \$5,180 in full satisfaction and settlement of all claims plaintiff may have against defendant Carolyn W. Colvin under § 2412 in this case. The award of attorney fees will satisfy all of plaintiff's claims for fees, costs and expenses under § 2412 in this case.

Any fees paid belong to plaintiff and not her attorney and can be offset to satisfy any pre-existing debt that plaintiff may owe to the United States. Plaintiff has provided defendant a valid assignment of fees. If defendant can verify that plaintiff does not owe pre-existing debt subject to offset, defendant will direct payment of the award to plaintiff's

attorney under the Equal Access to Justice Act assignment.
