ORDER

On November 10, 2014, Dana Duncan, counsel for plaintiff, filed a motion for leave to withdraw from his representation in this case.

In an order entered on December 9, 2014, I gave plaintiff until January 5, 2015, in which to contact the court to oppose counsel's request to withdraw and to advise the court whether he intends to continue to pursue this case, either pro se or with different counsel. In that order, I also advised plaintiff that if he failed to respond to the court by January 5, 2015, his case would be dismissed for failure to prosecute.

It is now February 14, 2015, and plaintiff has not responded to the court's order. Therefore, I will grant Attorney Duncan's motion to withdraw and, as warned, I will dismiss the case for failure to prosecute under Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(b).

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that

1. Dana Duncan's motion for leave to withdraw as counsel for plaintiff Dana Martin, dkt. #11, is GRANTED. Attorney Duncan is directed to serve a copy of this order on plaintiff.

2. The case is dismissed with prejudice for plaintiff's failure to prosecute it. The clerk of court is directed to enter judgment and close this case.
