ORDER

Plaintiff Sherrie Delong filed this case on June 3, 2014, seeking judicial review of a decision of the Commissioner of Social Security pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 405(g), as well as leave to proceed in forma pauperis. On June 11, 2014, this court entered an order denying her application for leave to proceed in forma pauperis and giving plaintiff until July 10, 2014 to submit the \$400 filing fee. The magistrate judge warned plaintiff that if she failed to submit the filing fee her complaint would be dismissed for her failure to prosecute this case. It is now July 24, 2014 and plaintiff has not submitted the filing fee or responded to the court's order. Accordingly, plaintiff's case will be dismissed.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that this case is DISMISSED without prejudice for plaintiff Sherrie Delong's failure to prosecute it. The clerk of court is directed to enter judgment in favor of

defendant Carolyn W. Colvin, Acting Commissioner of Social Security and close this case.
