Defendant Trevor Ryan has filed a motion to withdraw certain of his §2255 claims and for an extension of time to file his reply brief in support of his remaining claim. Defendant says that he wishes to withdraw all claims of alleged ineffective assistance of counsel with the exception of the claim that his defense counsel failed to pursue a Fourth Amendment defense following what he alleges was an illegal search and seizure of his person and property.

I will grant both motions and give defendant until August 8, 2004, in which to file his reply brief.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that all claims of alleged ineffective assistance of counsel with the exception of the claim that his defense counsel failed to pursue a Fourth Amendment defense following what he maintains was an illegal search and seizure of his property and person are considered WITHDRAWN.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that defendant Trevor Ryan's request for an extension of time to file his reply brief in support of his § 2255 motion is GRANTED. Defendant's reply brief is due August 15, 2014.
