The court held a telephonic conference today at which the parties appeared by counsel. Consistent with that hearing, the court issues the following order:

- 1) If the jury should find as a matter of fact that defendant BLM Land, LLC failed to file the correct Declaration of Restrictive Covenant, defendant may have until 5:00 p.m. on Friday, May 1, 2015, to submit a brief describing why it nevertheless is entitled to judgment as a matter of law on DRM's breach of contract claim. Plaintiff DRM, Inc.'s response to this brief is due by 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, May 5, 2015.
- 2) If the jury should find as a matter of fact that the Restrictive Covenant was proper as filed, plaintiff DRM, Inc. may have until 5:00 p.m. on Friday, May 1, 2015, to submit a brief explaining why it is entitled to judgment as a matter of law on BLM's tortious interference claim. Defendant BLM's response to this brief is due by 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, May 5, 2015.
- 3) The jury for this trial will be selected on Monday, May 11, 2015, by Magistrate Judge Crocker. Jury selection likely will not begin until 1:30 p.m. unless one or both of the other scheduled trials for that week settles, in which case the parties

will be notified of an earlier start time.<sup>1</sup> Introductory instructions to the jury, followed by opening statements will begin on Wednesday, May 13, 2015, at 1:30 p.m.
