ORDER

Petitioner Kenneth R. Smith has filed two new motions: one for reconsideration of this court's denial of his motion to vacate his sentence under Rule 60(b), dkt. #9, and one to "petition the court to supplement the original § 2251 [sic] motion to vacate, set aside, or correct sentence." Dkt. #10. These are the third and fourth motions for reconsideration of one sort or another. They will be denied.

Petitioner began his post conviction attack on his 2009 sentence for child pornography offenses by filing an untimely motion for post conviction relief on November 23, 2015, dkt. #23 (08-cr-188). This motion was denied, both because it was untimely and because he had no grounds for vacating the convictions. Thereupon, he filed two more motions, one for clarification, dkt. #6, and one for reconsideration. Dkt. #6. These were denied as well.

Now, petitioner has filed two more motions. Nothing in either of them shows that

it was error to find that petitioner's motion under 28 U.S.C. § 2255 and his two succeeding motions were untimely and without merit. Accordingly, his newly-filed motions for reconsideration and to supplement will be denied.

#### ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that petitioner Kenneth R. Smith's motions for reconsideration of this court's denial of his motion to vacate his sentence under Rule 60(b), dkt. #9, and to "petition the court to supplement the original § 2251 [sic] motion to vacate, set aside, or correct sentence, dkt. #10, are DENIED. If petitioner files any more motions for reconsideration, it is likely they will be denied without explanation.
