15-cv-284-wmc

With summary judgments looming, the parties in both of these cases (and represented by the same counsel), filed joint motions to stay litigation to allow for additional administrative review. The court granted both motions, but kept the trial dates in place, and set both cases for a telephonic status conference today to reset a potential schedule if necessary.

During today's conference, counsel advised that the administrative proceedings had been held up in both cases, but they were hopeful for completion soon and proposed

to reschedule the dispositive motion deadline for Case No. 15-cv-284 to August 9, 2016, and for Case No. 15-cv-282 to August 16, 2016, representing to the court that all issues would be presented on undisputed facts. Based on that representation, the court will reschedule accordingly. Failure to complete any further administrative review and file a dispositive motion based on undisputed facts by the deadlines above will result in the administrative closing of that case, allowing for reopening only upon good cause shown.

#### ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1) The deadline for filing dispositive motions in Case No. 15-cv-282-wmc is August 16, 2016;
- 2) The deadline for filing dispositive motions in Case No. 15-cv-284-wmc is August 9, 2016;
- 3) Responses to any dispositive motion filed shall be due within 21 days; with replies, if any, due within 10 days thereafter;
- 4) All other deadlines are STRUCK; and
- 5) Failure to complete any further administrative review and file a dispositive motion based on undisputed facts by the deadlines above will result in the administrative closing of that case, allowing for reopening only upon good cause shown.
