RE: ASSIGNMENT OF CASES

ORDER


All civil cases filed after August 15, 2012, will be assigned one-third to District Judge Conley, one-third to District Judge Crabb and one-third to Magistrate Judge Crocker, with the exception of social security appeals, bankruptcy appeals, federal collection and foreclosure actions, actions initiated by a self-represented plaintiff, motions brought pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2255 and petitions for a writ of habeas corpus pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2241 or § 2254. Cases assigned to Magistrate Judge Crocker in which written consent of all parties is not obtained under 28 U.S.C. § 636 will be randomly reassigned fifty percent to District Judge Conley and fifty percent to District Judge Crabb. In the event of a recusal, the case will be randomly reassigned fifty percent each to the non-recusing judges.

Motions brought pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2255 will be assigned to the sentencing judge unless the judge is no longer serving, in which event they will be assigned to District Judge Conley. Any closed case that is presently assigned to Judge Shabaz will be reassigned to District Judge Conley if judicial action is required.

All other cases filed in or transferred to this district after August 15, 2012, that are not assigned as set forth above will be assigned fifty percent to District Judge Conley and fifty percent to District Judge Crabb.
