
All civil cases filed after June 1, 2014, will be assigned two-sevenths each to District Judges Conley and Peterson and Magistrate Judge Crocker, and one-seventh to District Judge Crabb, with the exception of social security appeals, bankruptcy appeals, federal collection and foreclosure actions, actions initiated by a self-represented plaintiff, motions brought pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2255 and petitions for a writ of habeas corpus pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2241 or § 2254. Cases assigned to Magistrate Judge Crocker in which written consent of all parties is not obtained under 28 U.S.C. § 636 will be randomly reassigned forty percent to District Judges Conley and Peterson and 20 percent to District Judge Crabb. In the event of a recusal, the case will be randomly reassigned in the same proportions to the non-recusing judges.

Motions brought pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2255 will be assigned to the sentencing judge unless the judge is no longer serving in this district, in which event they will be randomly assigned fifty percent each to District Judges Conley and Peterson. Any closed case that is presently assigned to a judge no longer serving in this district will be randomly reassigned fifty percent each to District Judges Conley and Peterson if judicial action is required.

All other cases filed in or transferred to this district after June 1, 2014, that are not assigned as set forth above will be assigned forty percent each to District Judges Conley and Peterson and twenty percent to District Judge Crabb.
