RE: ASSIGNMENT OF CASES

ORDER

All cases filed in or transferred to this district after May 15, 2017, will be assigned as follows:

- Criminal cases will be assigned one-half each to District Judges Peterson and Conley.
- Pro se civil cases will be assigned two-fifths each to District Judges Peterson and Conley, and one-fifth to District Judge Crabb.
- Patent cases will be assigned one-half each to District Judges Peterson and Conley.
- Social Security cases will be assigned three-ninths each to District Judges Peterson and Conley, one-ninth to Magistrate Judge Crocker, and two-ninths to District Judge Crabb.
- Non-magistrate judge cases will be assigned two-fifths each to District Judges Peterson and Conley, and one-fifth to District Judge Crabb.
- Counseled civil rights cases will be assigned three-ninths each to District Judges Peterson and Conley, and one-ninth to Magistrate Judge Crocker, and two-ninths to District Judge Crabb.
- Other civil cases will be assigned four-ninths each to District Judges Peterson and Conley and one-ninth to Magistrate Judge Crocker.
- Any closed case that is presently assigned to a judge no longer serving in this district and any motion pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2255 where the sentencing judge is no longer

serving in this district will be randomly assigned one-half each to District Judges Peterson and Conley.
