ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 439

Any party seeking after-hours emergency injunctive relief from the District Court in connection with the 2024 election must do the following:

The petitioner shall contact the Clerk of Court by calling (608) 261-5717 to advise the clerk that the petitioner is preparing to move for emergency injunctive relief. Any request for emergency relief **must be presented in the form of a written motion** in accordance with the court's <u>Procedure to be Followed on Motions for Injunctive Relief</u>. The petitioner shall send a copy of the motion, which must be signed by the petitioner or petitioner's counsel, to clerkofcourt@wiwd.uscourts.gov.

The clerk will advise the duty judge that a motion is expected. If the petitioner is represented by counsel, then counsel will be instructed to open a new civil case in the court's electronic filing system, CM/ECF, and to promptly file the motion. If the petitioner is not represented by counsel, then the petitioner will be instructed how to initiate a new case. Any filing fee will be collected when the court opens for business on November 6.

The duty judge will review the motion and will determine how to proceed. This procedure applies only to motions seeking emergency injunctive relief after 4:30 p.m. on November 5, 2024, and before 8:00 a.m. on November 6, 2024. Any case filed during regular business hours (8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.) will be governed by the court's standard <u>Electronic Filing Procedures</u>.
