ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 446

The assignment of criminal cases to magistrate judges shall be modified as follows:

Prior to this order and upon her appointment, Magistrate Judge Anita M. Boor maintained blanket recusal from all criminal cases initiated during her tenure with the United States Attorney's Office. Such cases were assigned to Magistrate Judge Stephen L. Crocker during his recall status.

With Magistrate Judge Crocker's recall status ending April 30, 2025, and given that more than twelve months have elapsed since Magistrate Anita M. Boor's service with the United States Attorney's office ended, the court hereby orders:

1. Magistrate Judge Anita M. Boor shall be assigned to all criminal cases, effective immediately, without regard to the date of case initiation at the United States Attorney's Office.

2. Magistrate Judge Anita M. Boor shall exercise discretionary recusal in accordance with The Code of Conduct for United States Judges, Canon 3(C).

3. The United States Attorney's Office shall revise its criminal cover sheets to reflect this change.
