In an order dated October 31, 2016, I allowed pro se plaintiff Valiant Green to proceed on several claims regarding events at the Kenosha County Detention Facility, where plaintiff was incarcerated in 2014. (Plaintiff is now incarcerated at the New Lisbon Correctional Facility.) Although I stayed the case pending recruitment of counsel, it makes sense to perform service on the three named defendants in the meantime, to prevent unnecessary delays once the stay is lifted. Because plaintiff is proceeding in forma pauperis under 28 U.S.C. § 1915, service will be accomplished by the United States Marshal Service. (The marshals may notice that defendants may be employed at a facility in the Eastern District of Wisconsin. Because an objection to venue can be waived, it is not an issue generally raised by the court on its own motion. Automobile Mechanics Local 701 Welfare & Pension Funds v. Vanguard Car Rental USA, Inc., 502 F.3d 740, 746 (7th Cir. 2007).)

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that

1. The clerk of court is directed to forward summonses and copies of plaintiff Valiant Green's amended complaint, dkt. #18, the decision of the Court of Appeals for the Seventh Circuit, dkt. #35, the order granting plaintiff leave to proceed, dkt. #36, and this order to the United States Marshal for service on defendants David Beth, Brad Heilet and Dave Lianeu. The marshals must make reasonable efforts to locate and serve each of these defendants. Williams v. Werlinger, 795 F.3d 759 (7th Cir. 2015).

2. The stay is lifted for the purpose of serving the amended complaint on defendants Beth, Heilet and Lianeu and allowing those defendants to file an answer. The stay remains in effect in all other respects.
