On January 12, 2007, this court received defendant Joey Hicks's renewed request to be returned to Dodge Correctional Institution pending this court's February 8, 2007 hearing on the petition to revoke Hicks's supervised release. *See* *dk.* 192. Hicks alleges that he just has been alerted that DCI received paperwork regarding Hicks's divorce case, to which he believes he has only 30 days to respond. Hicks's life seems always to be in crisis mode, but I will assume that this is an accurate and complete report of his situation. It does not change this court's decision to hold Hicks at the Dane County Jail for the next three weeks. The collision of legal proceedings in Hicks's life likely qualifies as good cause for a deadline extension from the court presiding over his divorce case. Hicks should seek relief from that court because this court is not going to return Hicks to state custody until it determines whether to revoke his supervised release.
