On January 30, 2007, this court held an initial appearance on the government's motion to revoke defendant Frederick A. Cunningham's supervised release. Cunningham was present with his attorney, Erika Bierma. The government was represented by Assistant United States Attorney Timothy O'Shea and United States Probation Officer William T. Badger, Jr.

In response to the government's motion to detain Cunningham pending further proceedings, Cunningham did not contest probable cause or detention at this time. Accordingly, I held him to answer to the district judge. The revocation hearing is set for February 21, 2007 at 1:00 p.m. The parties are predicting a 20-30 minute hearing.
