ORDER

On May 8, 2014, defendant Michael Paul De Angelo filed a motion to reduce his monthly restitution payments, explaining that the \$161.70 that is currently being withheld from his monthly social security disability payment under the Treasury Offset Program is creating a financial hardship for him.

The government objects to defendant's motion but agrees to voluntarily remove defendant from the offset program provided he make timely monthly restitution payments of \$100 per month. In the event defendant fails to do so, the government reserves the right to reinstate payments toward restitution through the Treasury Offset Program.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that defendant Michael Paul De Angelo's motion to reduce his monthly restitution payments is GRANTED. Defendant is to pay \$100 per month to the

Clerk of Court for the Western District of Wisconsin with the understanding that if he fails to make a timely payment, the government may reinstate payments through the Treasury Offset Program.
