Petitioner Lawrence Norman, a prisoner at the Winnebago Mental Health Institution in Winnebago, Wisconsin, has filed a proposed amended complaint in this action, which I construe to include a motion to reopen this case. The motion will be denied.

In March 1999, I denied petitioner's request for leave to proceed <u>in forma pauperis</u> because he does not qualify for pauper status under the three-strike provision of 28 U.S.C. § 1915. Petitioner did not choose the only alternative route he had to prosecute his action, which was to pay the \$150 fee for filing the case. Therefore, the case was closed. If

petitioner now wishes to file an "amended" complaint, he will have to file a new action and pay the filing fee.

Accordingly, petitioner's motion to reopen this case is DENIED.
