CHARLES SIEGLER

On July 3, 2014, this court entered an order revoking defendant Charles Siegler's supervised release and imposing a sentence of 18 months' imprisonment in this case. On October 27, 2014, Siegler filed a motion requesting production of copies "at government expense" of the original indictment, plea agreement, judgment and sentencing transcript in connection with his underlying conviction. An indigent inmate does not have an unfettered constitutional right to free transcripts and court records. *See United States v. MacCollom*, 426 U.S. 317 (1976). Siegler has not filed a notice of appeal from the judgment of revocation and his time to do so has expired. Siegler does not otherwise explain why he needs these documents. Accordingly, his motion for free copies of court records and transcripts will be denied.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that defendant Charles Siegler's motion for the production of documents at government expense (dkt. # 58) is DENIED. For his convenience, the clerk's office will provide Siegler with a copy of the docket sheet in this case along with instructions on how to order copies for purchase.
