Plaintiff has filed a notice of appeal from this court's order of July 11, 2003, denying his purported Rule 60 motion to alter or amend the judgment entered in this case on December 5, 2001. Plaintiff's notice of appeal is not accompanied by the \$105 fee for filing the appeal. He will have to pay it in full if he wishes to take an appeal, because he does not qualify for pauper status under 28 U.S.C. § 1915. See Robinson v. Powell, 297 F.3d 540 (7th Cir. 2002) (dismissing plaintiff's appeal because of his three-strike status under 28 U.S.C. § 1915(g)).

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that plaintiff's request for leave to proceed in forma

<u>pauperis</u> on appeal is DENIED because three strikes have been recorded against plaintiff under 28 U.S.C. § 1915(g).
