Dennis Jones'El has filed a document titled, "Joint Legal Matters and Affidavit in Support of Request to Federal Judge to Review Provision of Prison Litigation Reform Act ("PLRA") Governing Settlement Agreement With Regard to Parties Agreeing to Have a Court Approved Monitor." In this document, plaintiff contends that he is being denied

access to a court approved monitor, which means that he and other members of the class are

Mr. Dickey may be reached. Because the appointment of Walter Dickey to serve as monitor

in this action moots the matters raised in plaintiff Jones'El's submission, no further action

will be taken with respect to it.
