On October 27, 2005, this court held the initial appearance pursuant to Rule 32.1 on the petition to revoke the supervised release of defendant Justin Franklin. Franklin was present with his attorney, Kelly Welsh. The government was represented by Assistant United States Attorney Robert Anderson and United States Probation Officer Helen Raatz.

Although Franklin's detention status remains unclear, at least for now the government has moved to detain him pending further proceedings. Franklin waived a probable cause hearing and is not contesting detention at this time. The revocation hearing before Judge Shabaz has been set for November 10, 2005, at 1:45 p.m. The parties had no other matters to bring to the court's attention.
