IT IS ORDERED that

1. Plaintiff Jerry Charles is assessed an initial partial payment of the \$105 fee for filing his appeal in the amount of \$11.00. Plaintiff may have until January 2, 2003, in which to submit a check or money order to the clerk of court in that amount. If, by January

2, 2002, plaintiff fails to pay the initial partial payment or explain his failure to do so, then I will advise the court of appeals of his noncompliance in paying the assessment so that it may take whatever steps it deems appropriate with respect to this appeal.
