This case was dismissed on the ground that plaintiff had failed to amend his complaint to identify any individual who personally participated in denying him his prescribed medication for Dysthymic Disorder and Generalized Anxiety Disorder in June, 2001, while he was an inmate at the Waupun Correctional Institution. Subsequently, in an order dated August 15, 2002, I concluded that the dismissal was erroneous and vacated the judgment of dismissal. Since vacating the judgment, the court's mail to plaintiff has been returned to the court marked, "Return to Sender, No Forwarding Address." On September 17, 2002, counsel for defendants advised the court that plaintiff was released from custody and supervision on July 10, 2002, and that they have no address or telephone number for him.

Plaintiff's failure to advise the court and defendants of his whereabouts in the two and a half months since he was released from prison suggests that he is no longer interested in prosecuting this case. Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that this case is DISMISSED for plaintiff's failure to prosecute.
