On November 12, 2002, I denied plaintiff's motions for a preliminary injunction in this case and in another of plaintiff's cases, Walker v. Brant, 02-C-135-C. The motions were the same. Now plaintiff has filed identical notices of appeal from the order denying his motion for preliminary injunction. For the reasons stated in a separate order entered today in Walker v. ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that plaintiff's motion for leave to proceed <u>in forma pauperis</u> on appeal is DENIED and I certify that his appeal is not taken in good faith.

Further, IT IS ORDERED that plaintiff pay the \$105 fee for filing his appeal immediately, unless within thirty (30) days of the date of this order he exercises his right to ask the court of appeals to review this court's certification of bad faith.
