After defendant Canadian Rubber Industries, Ltd., was found guilty of wilful infringement under 35 U.S.C. § 285, plaintiff Promat Ltd., moved for an award of attorney fees. Plaintiff submitted proof of its reasonable attorney fees within ten days of entry of judgment, as directed by the court.

I have reviewed plaintiff's itemized statement of time and hourly rates spent in prosecuting this case. From my review, I am persuaded that the fees sought are reasonable, as is the amount of time spent on prosecution of the case. Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED

that Promat Ltd., is awarded \$171,398.70 as reasonable and necessary attorney fees in this case.
