A hearing on Cincinnati Insurance Company's motion for intervention was held by telephone in this case on December 13, 2002, before U.S. District Judge Barbara B. Crabb. Lynne M. Mueller participated on behalf of Cincinnati Insurance Company. Gordon

Davenport participated on behalf of plaintiff and Michael J. Modl, Andrew J. Clarkowski and Richard G. Neiss participated on behalf of defendant in various capacities.

After hearing argument from counsel, I granted the motion for intervention and reserved a ruling on the motion for stay to allow counsel an opportunity to brief it. The parties opposing the stay may have until January 6, 2003, in which to serve and file briefs in opposition. The intervener may have until January 16, 2003, in which to serve and file a reply brief.

Although I have reserved a ruling on the motion for stay, the case will proceed in the interim. The parties are to file and brief a motion on coverage. Cincinnati may have until January 6, 2003, in which to serve and file its brief in support of its position that its policies do not cover the claims in suit in this case. The parties opposing this position may have until January 27, 2003, in which to serve and file briefs in opposition and Cincinnati may have until February 7, 2003, in which to serve and file a reply brief.

I will proceed to decide the pending motion for summary judgment while the parties are briefing the other matters.
