On April 18, 2003, plaintiff Tony Walker filed notices of appeal from the judgments entered in these cases and requested leave to proceed on appeal in forma pauperis. On April 22, 2003, I entered an order in each case giving plaintiff until May 19, 2003, in which to submit a trust account statement for the six-month period beginning approximately October 19, 2002, to approximately April 19, 2003. I stated that if, by May 19, plaintiff failed to submit the required statement or show cause for his failure to do so, then I would deny his requests for leave to proceed in forma pauperis on appeal on the ground that he had failed to show that he is entitled to indigent status on appeal. Plaintiff did not submit the required trust fund account statement. Now, however, it has come to the court's attention that plaintiff probably did not receive the April 22 order. This is because the order was mailed to plaintiff at the Green Bay Correctional Institution instead of the Oshkosh Correctional Institution, which is where the envelope bearing plaintiff's notices of appeal showed his current place of incarceration to be. Therefore, I am enclosing to plaintiff with a copy of this order another copy of the April 22 orders. In addition, I will extend to June 28, 2003, the time within which plaintiff is to submit a trust fund account statement. To be current, the trust fund account statement should cover the six-month period beginning approximately January 1, 2003 and ending approximately June 1, 2003, instead of covering the six-month period identified in the April 22 order.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that plaintiff may have until June 28, 2003, in which to submit a certified copy of his trust fund account statement for the six-month period beginning approximately January 1, 2003, and ending approximately June 1, 2003. If, by June 28, 2003, plaintiff fails to submit the required statement or show cause for his failure to do so, then I will deny his requests for leave to proceed in forma pauperis on the ground that he has failed to show that he is entitled to indigent status on appeal.
