MEMORANDUM

02-C-450-C

A conference was held by telephone on December 19, 2003, before United States  
District Judge Barbara B. Crabb. Vincent Moccio participated on behalf of plaintiffs.

Michele Ford participated on behalf of defendants.

Ms. Ford advised the court that defendants will not object to the addition of any person to the class on the basis of timeliness, provided that the person to be added was actually subject to a strip search as defined for this case. Once counsel learn of any new proposed additions to the class, they will check the qualifications of those persons and will work together to obtain the jail files and other records that they need to make the determination of qualification.

Plaintiffs' counsel is sending notices to all class members other than juveniles. Ms. Ford will be sending the notices to the juveniles. The notice to juveniles includes a statement advising them that their records have not been turned over to the court or to defendants or their counsel.

Mr. Moccio has learned that at least two claimants are deceased and their widows have submitted claims. Counsel agree that widows and widowers of claimants will be eligible for settlement payments.
