Petitioner John Jaakkola has filed a document titled "Petition for Removal" and a petition for leave to proceed in this court in forma pauperis. Although the removal petition is difficult to understand, it appears from documents attached to it that petitioner is the plaintiff in a case currently pending in a state trial court in Michigan involving a traffic accident. Apparently, petitioner wishes to remove his case to this court because he feels he is not being treated fairly by the state trial judge and because the defendants are not adequately responding to his discovery requests.

Petitioner cannot remove the case he filed in Michigan state court to this court. As an initial matter, a *plaintiff* cannot remove a case he filed in state court to federal court. The

general federal removal statute allows only defendants, not plaintiffs, to remove a case. See

28 U.S.C. § 1441(a), 1446(a); 12 Moore's Federal Practice, § 107.11[2] (Matthew Bender

3d ed.) (noting that "a plaintiff who elected state court jurisdiction when filing the complaint

may not subsequently remove the action to federal court"). Moreover, it would be improper

under any circumstances to remove a case pending in a Michigan state court to this court

because a removal petition must be filed "in the district court of the United States for the

district and division within which such [state] action is pending." 28 U.S.C. § 1446(a); 12

Moore's Federal Practice, § 107.13. In short, petitioner's case is not removable to this court.

Because petitioner has not filed with this court all the documents required by the federal

removal statute, it is difficult to discern from which precise Michigan trial court this case was

removed. However, it appears from plaintiff's caption that it was removed from the circuit

court for Gogebic County, Michigan. Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that the case removed

by petitioner John Jaakkola is REMANDED to the circuit court for Gogebic County,

Michigan.
