This is a civil action for declaratory, injunctive and monetary relief in which plaintiff Edward J. Piscitello, an inmate at the Columbia Correctional Institution, claims that he was denied biblical counseling courses in violation of the First Amendment while housed at the Wisconsin Secure Program Facility.

Presently before the court is plaintiff's motion for an enlargement of time from January 10 to January 31, 2003, in which to file his brief in response to defendant's motion for summary judgment. (Plaintiff is under the mistaken impression that his brief in response is due on January 10. Because defendant filed his motion on December 19, 2002, plaintiff's response is due January 16, 2003.) Although plaintiff's reason for needing more time ("to send out documents and receive the needed papers") lacks the required detail to support an

extension, plaintiff nevertheless may have until January 20, 2003, to file his response.

Defendant may have until January 31, 2003, to reply. No further extensions will be given.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that plaintiff Edward J. Piscitello's motion for an enlargement of

time is GRANTED; plaintiff may have until January 20, 2003, to file his brief in response

to defendant's motion for summary judgment and defendant may have until January 31,

2003, to file his reply.
