The court held a scheduling conference by telephone in this case with Dan Graber, counsel for the government and Mark Eisenberg and Manual Hernandez, counsel for defendant. The purpose of the hearing was to advise counsel of the court's scheduling conflict and the need to find a new date for Mr. Tedder's trial. After some discussion, counsel agreed on Tuesday, May 27, 2003, for the start of trial. There is a possibility that the trial will extend into the week of June 2, 2003.

Defendant's counsel asked that defendant be released on bail conditions, given the continuance of the previous trial date. After hearing argument, I denied the request. I continue to believe that defendant represents a flight risk, as explained in prior rulings

denying his request for release. Neither defendant's difficulties in reviewing discovery nor his alleged lack of finances changes my opinion in this case.
