MEMORANDUM

A status conference was held by telephone in this case on July 15, 2003, before United States District Judge Barbara B. Crabb. The government was represented by Grant Johnson, Assistant United States Attorney. Defendant was represented by Elizabeth Edwards-Jones. Defendant was not present in person.

Ms. Edwards-Jones advised the court that a hearing will be held in California on Thursday, July 17, 2003, to determine whether Mr. Estrada-Becerra can withdraw his plea of guilty in a proceeding in that state. The government agreed that it would be willing to stay this matter for a period of two weeks to allow determination of defendant's right to withdraw his guilty plea. Mr. Johnson agreed that he would place a conference call at 1:30

p.m. on July 29, 2003, at which time Ms. Edwards-Jones can advise the court of the status of defendant's motion.
