In an order dated November 29, 2000, I noted that the defendant in this case had not been served with plaintiff's complaint because plaintiff had not provided an accurate address for her. I gave plaintiff until December 13, 2000, in which to provide the court with defendant McManus's new address. I advised him that if, by December 13, 2000, he failed to obtain McManus's address, I would dismiss this lawsuit on the court's own motion for his failure to prosecute unless he set out in writing the steps he had taken to discover defendant McManus's address and why he believes that he will learn the address promptly. Plaintiff has not responded to the November 29 order.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that this case is DISMISSED on the court's own motion for plaintiff's failure to prosecute.
