On March 4, 2004, I granted defendants' motion for summary judgment. Judgment of dismissal was entered on March 5, 2004 [docketed on March 8, 2004]. On April 5, 2004, plaintiff filed a notice of appeal and requested leave to proceed in forma pauperis on appeal. In an order dated April 6, 2004, I noted that plaintiff is not barred from proceeding on appeal under the in forma pauperis statute by the three strikes provision in 28 U.S.C. § 1915(g) and that I did not intend to certify that his appeal is not taken in good faith. However, I directed plaintiff to submit, no later than April 26, 2004, a certified copy of his trust fund account statement for the six-month period beginning approximately October 1, 2003, to approximately April 1, 2004. I advised plaintiff that if, by April 26, 2004, he

failed to submit the required trust account statement or show cause for his failure to do so, I would deny his request for leave to proceed <u>in forma pauperis</u> on the ground that he has failed to show that he is entitled to indigent status on appeal.

Now plaintiff has submitted the required trust fund account statement. From the statement, I conclude that he qualifies for indigent status, and that he must pay an initial partial payment to the clerk of this court in the amount of \$5.84.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that plaintiff Frederick Rogers may have until May 6, 2004, in which to submit a check or money order made payable to the Clerk of Court in the amount of \$5.84 as an initial partial payment of the fee for filing his appeal. The remainder of the \$255 fee must be paid in monthly installments according to 28 U.S.C. § 1915(b)(2).

If, by May 6, 2004, plaintiff fails to pay the initial partial payment, I will notify the

court of appeals so that it may take whatever action it deems appropriate with respect to this appeal.
