Petitioner Janice-Kay: Logan submitted an indecipherable application for a writ of habeas corpus pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2254. Petitioner used her own private language and omitted many facts material to her ability to seek and obtain habeas relief. On June 10, 2003, this court mailed petitioner a copy of a standard § 2254 form and ordered her to complete it using standard English and grammar. This court also sent petitioner an application form for leave to proceed <u>in forma pauperis</u>. The court set June 25, 2003 as the deadline for re-submission, warning petitioner that failure to comply with the order would result in the dismissal of her petition for failure to prosecute it.

Petitioner did not comply with the order. Instead, on July 7, 2003 petitioner filed another private language document in which she demanded that this court place her case on the trial calendar within 24 hours. Petitioner made no attempt to provide any of the information requested by the court, she did not seek clarification or additional time from the court and she did not attempt to establish her indigence. Petitioner's latest submission demonstrates her stubborn resolve to prosecute her case in the manner she prefers and not in the manner required by the statutes, rules, and court orders. Therefore, as this court warned petitioner, she will not be permitted to prosecute it in any manner.

ORDER

It is ORDERED that petitioner Janice-Kay: Logan's petition for a writ of habeas corpus is DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE for her failure to prosecute it.
