ORDER

In an order dated August 26, 2003, I granted plaintiff leave to proceed in forma pauperis on his claim that defendants Dennis Hillstead, Carmen Hansen, Karen Humphries and Sue Lindberg violated his Eighth Amendment right to receive adequate medical treatment when they gave him the wrong medication. Since that date, plaintiff has not communicated with the court. Defendants have attempted to serve plaintiff with their answers to his complaint and the court has attempted to serve plaintiff with notice of a preliminary pretrial conference to be held before the magistrate judge. This mail was sent to plaintiff at his last known address, 1385 Rolling Hills Dr., Maplewood, MN, 55119. It

has been returned to the court and opposing counsel marked “Attempted - Not Known, Unable to Forward.”

It appears from plaintiff's failure to advise the court and opposing counsel of his current address that he is no longer interested in prosecuting the case. Therefore, dismissal of the case appears appropriate.

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that this action is DISMISSED without prejudice for plaintiff's failure to prosecute.
