Defendant Duane F. Bowman has filed a motion to amend the order to vacate “to allow additional time for the Personal Representative of the Estate of Olympia G. Bowman to resume and complete his duties of disposing of the personal property of the Estate as decreed in the last Will and Testament of Olympia G. Bowman.” Defendant does not explain why it would be necessary to vacate the order for the purpose of allowing the personal representative to complete the disposition of Olympia G.
