On June 7, 2005, the court received a letter from Attorney Michael Hughes seeking clarification of this court's order of June 1, 2005, in which I explained that as court-appointed counsel for Chila Sanchez, Hughes was responsible for perfecting an appeal on her behalf. Hughes wants to be sure that after filing the notice of appeal, he is not responsible for representing Sanchez on appeal.

Hughes is correct: the scope of his appointment does not require him to represent Sanchez on appeal. However, because he will be deemed counsel of record on appeal pursuant to Seventh Circuit Rule 3(d), he will have to request permission to withdraw from

the court of appeals. I anticipate the court of appeals will grant that motion without hesitation.
