Defendant Vinette Burrlynn Crowley has filed a motion for a reduction of her sentence pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2255. She contends that her sentence is illegal because she was sentenced erroneously under the 1997 guidelines manual when she should have been sentenced under the 1995 manual and that the use of the 1997 manual raised her guideline range to 97-121 months. Had the probation officer used the 1995 guidelines, the base offense level would have been 30 rather than 32. Also, defendant contends that the government breached its promise to her that it would recommend a sentence of no more than 70 months.

The government may have until June 3, 2003, in which to file and serve a brief in opposition to defendant's motion. Defendant may have until June 20, 2003, in which to file and serve a reply brief.
