ORDER

03-CR-155-C

Defendant Scott Howard has filed a motion for an order directing the United States Marshals Service to transfer him for immediate psychological evaluation. The motion must be denied. It appears that defendant believes that he is not being protected or given adequate medical care while in county jails in Colorado and he wants the United States Marshal for the District of Colorado to transfer him.

Because defendant is physically located in the State of Colorado, he should file his motion with the United States District Court for the District of Colorado, which has jurisdiction over the jails in which defendant is located and the authority to direct the United States Marshal for the District of Colorado to take any action the court

believes is warranted. This court has no jurisdiction over defendant Howard or over any of the people who are alleged to be mistreating him.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that defendant Scott Howard's motion for an order directing the United States Marshals Service to transfer him for immediate psychological examination is DENIED.
