JUDGMENT

04-10028-X

The Court refers to 18 U.S.C. § 3553(b) for determination of the appropriate sentence because no guidelines have been expressly promulgated for the offenses of conviction. As to Violation No. 1051121, it is adjudged that defendant shall serve a one year sentence of probation beginning May 20, 2005. As special conditions of probation, defendant shall:

1) Spend 30 days at Fahrman Center in Eau Claire, Wisconsin, with admission on or after November 7, 2005, as directed by the supervising probation officer. The defendant may be absent from the center for employment purposes, for mental health counseling and treatment, and for passes consistent with program rules. The defendant is to pay his own medical expenses, if any, and is to pay 25% of his gross income toward the cost of the daily per diem.

2) Register with local law enforcement agencies and the state attorney general, as directed by the supervising U.S. probation officer; and

3) Refrain from the excessive use of alcohol and participate in substance abuse treatment and testing as directed by the supervising U.S. probation officer.

Defendant's driving privileges are revoked for a period of six months in addition to any previous revocation orders.

The court orders the U.S. Attorney's Office to furnish the Judge Advocate's Office, an FRC-FM-JA, Attn: "Byers," 100 East Headquarters Road, Fort McCoy, Wisconsin 54656-5263, with a copy of the judgment order so that the Provost Marshal's Office may notify the Department of Transportation.

It is adjudged that the defendant is to pay a \$25 criminal assessment penalty and a \$100 fine as to Violation No. 1051121 and a \$5 criminal assessment penalty and a \$100 fine as to Violation No. 1051119. All of the financial penalties are to be paid to the Central Violations Bureau, P.O. Box 740026, Atlanta, Georgia 30374-0026. Defendant shall complete payment of all assessments and fines not later than July 22, 2005.
