Plaintiff William Faulkner, a prisoner at the Stanley Correctional Institution in Stanley, Wisconsin, has submitted two proposed complaints. He has paid the \$150 filing fee for each case. Nevertheless, because he is a prisoner, he is subject to the 1996 Prison Litigation Reform Act. Under the act, plaintiff cannot proceed with these actions unless the court grants him permission to proceed after screening his complaints pursuant to 28 U.S.C.

§ 1915A.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that plaintiff's complaints are taken under advisement. As soon as the court's calendar permits, plaintiff's complaints will be screened pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915A to determine whether the cases must be dismissed either because the complaints are frivolous or malicious, fail to state a claim on which relief may be granted or seek monetary relief against a defendant who is immune from such relief. Plaintiff will be notified promptly when the decisions have been made.
