In an entered on October 13, 2005, I directed plaintiff to submit a trust fund account statement as required by 28 U.S.C. § 1915(a)(2) to support his request for leave to proceed in forma pauperis on appeal. I told plaintiff that if, by November 3, 2005, he failed to submit the trust fund account statement, his request for leave to proceed would be denied for his failure to show that he is entitled to indigent status on appeal. Plaintiff did not submit the required trust fund account statement. However, at about the time the statement was due, the court discovered that plaintiff had been transferred from the Redgranite Correctional Institution to the Milwaukee Secure Detention Facility. Surmising that plaintiff had not received the October 13 order, I entered an order on November 7, 2005,

extending plaintiff's deadline to December 5, 2005. That order was mailed to the Milwaukee Secure Detention Facility and has not been returned to the court. Nevertheless, plaintiff has not submitted the required trust fund account statement.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that plaintiff's request for leave to proceed <u>in forma</u> <u>pauperis</u> on appeal is DENIED on the ground that he has failed to show that he is entitled to indigent status.
