This case is scheduled for jury trial during the week beginning January 9, 2006. In an order dated August 17, 2005, the court described the procedures that will govern the trial and elements that plaintiff must establish at trial to prevail on his claim. In the event that either party has misplaced his copy of that order, I am enclosing a copy of the order with this order. Plaintiff should note in particular that the August 17, 2005 order instructs the parties to file their proposed voir dire questions, special verdict forms and jury instructions not later than seven calendar days before trial. Also, I will direct the clerk of court to issue another writ of habeas corpus ad testificandum for plaintiff's attendance at trial, as the earlier issued writ was cancelled.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that the clerk of court shall issue a writ of habeas corpus ad testificandum for prison inmate Gary Campbell to appear at the trial beginning January 9, 2006.
