On February 13, 2006 the Court remanded this case to the Commissioner for further proceedings. On April 17, 2006 Administrative Law Judge granted plaintiff Social Security benefits. Plaintiff's past due benefits were \$39,498.00.

On February 9, 2007 plaintiff moved pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 406(b) for the approval of attorney fees of \$9,874.00, 25% of that amount. Plaintiff agreed to this fee agreement on August 21, 2001. This motion will be granted as it is unopposed and the fees are reasonable. Accordingly, the Court will approve attorney fees in the amount of \$9,874.00.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that plaintiff's motion for the approval of attorney fees in the amount of \$9,874.00 is GRANTED.
