I told plaintiff also that if he failed to submit the required trust fund account statement, I would deny his request for leave to proceed <u>in formatory pauperis</u> on appeal on the ground that he had failed to show that he was entitled to indigent status on appeal.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that plaintiff's notice of appeal is to be docketed in case no. 04-C-977-C.

Further, IT IS ORDERED that plaintiff's request for leave to proceed <u>in forma</u> <u>pauperis</u> on appeal in case no. 04-C-977-C is DENIED on the ground that plaintiff has failed to show that he qualifies for indigent status on appeal.
